

**BOYD COUNTY FISCAL COURT
ORDINANCE NO. 04-02**

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO SOLID WASTE CONTROL

BE IT ORDAINED by the Fiscal Court of Boyd County, Kentucky:

In furtherance of solid waste management in Boyd County, Kentucky, it is required that any person and/or company engaged in the practice of hauling solid waste in Boyd County, Kentucky, must use a tarpaulin sufficient to secure said solid waste from blowing out.

The penalty for any person and/or company for failure to use a tarpaulin shall be:

- (a) Up to \$100.00 for a first time offense within a 5 year period; and
- (b) Up to \$500.00 for each subsequent offense within a 5 year period.

Any and all ordinances previously adopted which are in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed but only to the extent of said conflict.

This ordinance shall be in effect upon its adoption, re-adoption and publication according to law.

Should any portion of this ordinance be declared invalid, unconstitutional or otherwise unenforceable, then only that portion so declared shall be affected and all other portions shall in full force and effect until otherwise determined.
