

BOYD COUNTY FISCAL COURT**ORDINANCE NO. 05-2012****AN ORDINANCE AMENDING BOYD COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 05-01 SO AS TO PROVIDE FOR A PENALTY FOR PERSONS WHO FAIL AND/OR REFUSE TO OBTAIN A BUSINESS LICENSE****BE IT ORDAINED** by the Fiscal Court of Boyd County, Kentucky as follows:

1. Any person, firm, corporation, entity, partnership or other business organization that fails and/or refuses to obtain a business license, hereafter "Violator" shall be subject to a penalty which is equivalent of a Class A Misdemeanor under the Kentucky Penal Code, to wit: A fine of up to \$500.00 and/or imprisonment for up to one (1) year or both.
2. Prior to being convicted of the penalty set out above, the person in violation shall first receive a notice from Boyd County Code Enforcement or other such persons as the Boyd County Judge Executive may deem appropriate requiring the party secure the business license within three (3) business days of the date of the citation. Upon failure to secure the business license a complaint and/or citation may be taken or issued against the Violator requiring his or her appearance or that of the Violators legal representative in the Boyd District Court to answer for the Misdemeanor offense. Each and every day that the violator fails to secure a business license from and after the three (3) day grace period set out above shall constitute a separate and distinct violation and there shall not be any necessity for further citations or criminal complaints be issued.

3. This Ordinance shall be in effective upon its adoption, re-adoption and publication according to law.

4. Any Ordinances in conflict herewith **BE AND HEREBY ARE RE-PEALED** but only to the extent of said conflict and only upon declaration of competent and lawful jurisdiction.
